Opening times

Open Studio Fridays

10:00 - 17:00 at Pervasive Media Studio

Our weekly offer to come and spend time with us in the Studio, and get to know the space and the community.

The Studio provides chairs, tables, wireless and a great space. You bring what you need to work with (laptop/mobile). Tell us what you're up to, or allow us to help make conversations within the resident community happen. Studio staff and residents will be around to chat, answer questions, or tell you more about what we do. The open afternoons close at 17:00, sometimes with a trip to the Café & Bar.

As part of Open Studio Fridays we present a **Lunchtime Talk** each week, which usually takes place at 13:00 on a Friday, are free and are open to everybody. The talks are a series of informal presentations and we host them in the [Pervasive Media Studio](#) and we also stream them online on YouTube.

Come along, bring a sandwich, and get to know more about the Studio community. Find out about current and up-coming projects, or residents' work.

The Studio is beyond the Café & Bar, turn right and then go down the corridor to your left (where the toilets are). The double doors here will be open, go all the way down until you reach the Studio. A member of staff will sign you in, and check your ticket, if you have booked.

Access

At Watershed we want to be as welcoming, inclusive and accessible as we can for all our customers, audiences, staff and visitors.

Our building is accessible, our customer facing staff have received basic BSL and Deaf awareness training and we run an accessible programme of screenings and events. We have both gender neutral and gender specific toilets as well as two accessible toilets.

Our toilets in the top foyer are for everyone - some of the fully enclosed cubicles have a sink and mirror in them, some are ambulant (a bit more spacious with supports such as grab rails) and there is also a large family room with plenty of room for a buggy. Just through the Café & Bar we still have separate male and female toilets.

Our main entrance and Box Office are both on the ground floor which is accessible via a ramped, electronically assisted entrance door.

There are two Blue Badge parking spaces to the rear of Watershed on Canons Road.

Guide dogs and hearing dogs are very welcome.

The first floor of Watershed is accessible via the lift from the main entrance and includes **level access** to all areas, including:

- the front of Cinemas 1 and 2, plus a lift to the back of Cinemas 1 and 3
- all [events spaces](#)
- the [Pervasive Media Studio](#), our research and development space

- a large and spacious [Café & Bar](#)

The ticket scanner at the Cinema entrance is wheelchair accessible.

All three cinemas have induction loops as do our Waterside 2 and Waterside 3 event spaces.

There are two **accessible toilets** (with baby changing facilities). One in the top foyer, beside our toilets, or follow the signs for the Cinemas for the second accessible toilet on your left through the double doors before Cinema 1.

Our toilets in the top foyer **are for everyone** - some of the fully enclosed cubicles have a sink and mirror in them, some are ambulant (a bit more spacious with supports such as grab rails) and there is also a large family room with plenty of room for a buggy. Just through the Café & Bar we still have separate male and female toilets.
