

# About Trigger

Trigger is a producer led arts organisation making site-specific and site responsive cross artform theatre. It puts the audience in the centre of the action, it's highly participative. The company is led by award winning Producer and Artistic Director Angie Bual and Natalie Adams. Trigger are based in Bristol, residents of the Pervasive Media Studio, Watershed.

## About the project

The event is a major new site specific work programmed as part of Mayflower 400 in Plymouth 2020. The creative team include puppet director of War Horse, **Mervyn Millar**, a kite world champion flier and set designer for Bjork, **Carl Robertshaw**, award winning Artistic Director **Angie Bual** and producers Trigger.



In partnership with Arts Council England, Plymouth City Council and Theatre Royal Plymouth this project fuses myth, legend, science, puppetry & aerodynamics into



one unforgettable event, which will use the city centre of Plymouth and The Hoe as a stage.

The final event will play to an audience of over 40,000 people over 2 days in August 2020 and will have extensive local and national press coverage (radio and broadcast).

We are looking for an organised, diligent and personable Stage Manager & Show Caller for Trigger's upcoming production of a major new site-specific work.

Applicants will be considered from Plymouth and outside of Plymouth.

#### Job Description

Responsible to: Lead Stage Manager Responsible for: Stage management volunteers Working with: Creative Team, Associate Creative Team, Production Team, Producers, Cast and Crew, and external partners

To work as part of the Stage Management team to facilitate the creation and smooth running of the Hatchling event and final production. Meeting standards set by the Director and Creative team and to participate in the day to day running of the Stage Management team.

#### Main duties:

- The Stage Manager & Show Caller will need to have the ability to self motivate, communicate and work well both within a team and under pressure.
- To provide accurate rehearsal notes following consultation with the director
- To distribute daily to the production and creative teams.
- To coordinate with the director and stage manager all necessary rehearsal calls including costume fittings and media events.
- To produce a prompt copy for cueing the final show piece.
- To assist the Lead Stage Manager with the pastoral care of the company and creative team through out the rehearsal and show period.
- Attend and contribute to production meetings.
- To be comfortable interacting with members of the public during the event in order to oversee the smooth running of the performance/ event in Plymouth city centre.
